- My personal assistant typed "andandand" instead of "and and and". I told her, "There should be a space between, and and and, and and and and".
- They were too close to the door to close it.

- If fish can hear, would, to a bass, bass be deep?

Homophones

Words that sound alike but with different meanings and spellings.

- In matters of principle, the deans and principal of the school set the quidelines for teachers and students.
- I saw your eye after you found out I hit you in your eye.
- There has to be an explanation for their actions—they're painted in guilt!




